Well, the embargo is now lifted, the rumours are real, the twitters are true – **Tamworth Festival 2011**, **Bucko & Champs ARE BACK**, a little older and no wiser, proudly presenting **three big shows**!

They have won **10 Golden Guitar awards** between them and proudly fly the flag as two of our finest, distinctly Australian singer/songwriters - who aren't afraid to have a good chuckle along the way! Together, their iconic **"Aussie Christmas with Bucko & Champs"** has sold over 100,000 albums – and counting! Greg Champion – "Champs" – has weaved a unique path as the AFL's #1 footy troubadour, radio stalwart (as longtime member of the "Coodabeen Champions") and – seriously – the man responsible for a country music career full of songs with heart, depth – and a healthy pinch of mirth.

Colin Buchanan – "Bucko" – is respected as one of Australian Country Music's most important songwriters of the last 25 years. Apart from his successful solo career, his songs recorded by the likes of Lee Kernagahan, Slim Dusty, Troy Cassar-Daley and many others. 2011 sees the release of "The Songwriter Sessions" – a landmark CD/DVD featuring many of his collaborators.

Champs & Bucko - Their live shows are quirky, always unpredictable and completely unforgettable! Like Roy Rogers & Gene Autrey, like Butch & Sundance, like Calamity Jane & Popeye, this pair of Saddle-polished Cowboys are giving their wild palaminos a grease and oil change in readiness for the triumphant ride into Tamworth, six-guns blazing, offering Festival fans some good old-fashioned Gold Medal hootin' tootin' electrocutin' entertainment, Country Music and fun!
